

VEHICLE VERIFICATION FORM

IMPORTED MOTOR VEHICLES ARE SUBJECT TO SAFETY STANDARDS UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE SAFETY ACT OF 1966, REVISED UNDER THE IMPORTED VEHICLE SAFETY COMPLIANCE ACT OF 1988; TO BUMPER STANDARDS UNDER THE MOTOR VEHICLE INFORMATION AND COST SAVINGS ACT OF 1972, WHICH BECAME EFFECTIVE IN 1978; AND TO AIR POLLUTION CONTROL STANDARDS UNDER THE CLEAN AIR ACT OF 1968, AS AMENDED IN 1977, AND 1990. You may submit the required DOT and EPA forms to us or we can submit forms on your behalf. In order for Heizwerthy to submit, please verify your vehicle confirms to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards by selecting one of the following:

DOT/NHTSA Declaration

1. The vehicle is 25 or more years old or the equipment item was manufactured on a date when no applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard or Theft Prevention Standard was in effect.

2A. The vehicle or equipment item conforms to all applicable Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standards (or the vehicle does not conform solely because readily attachable equipment items that will be attached to it before it is offered for sale to the first purchaser for purposes other than resale are not attached), and Bumper and Theft Prevention Standards, and bears a certification label or tag to that effect permanently affixed by the original manufacturer to the vehicle or affixed by the manufacturer to the equipment item or to its delivery container in accordance with applicable National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) regulations [591.5(b)];

I confirm my vehicle is a U.S. Conforming vehicle that is US certified – an unmodified vehicle bearing a U.S. EPA emission control label in engine compartment (or on motorcycle frame) in English.

Additional Customs Fees

If your vehicle is foreign made, 2.5% duty + processing fees are payable to US customs unless you have proof the car was exported from the United States and is returning to the United States. Acceptable proof of export from the United States include:

1. A Manufacturer's affidavit
2. A previous bill of lading showing the vehicle being exported from the US
3. A previous title/ registration/ insurance showing the vehicle in the US
4. A Carfax report showing the vehicle being previously in the US
5. A 7501 from the dealer showing where it was imported into the Virgin Islands from the US

It is at the port director's discretion if additional documentation will be requested.
